Parents may elect to purchase dress khaki bottoms from other providers. How ever these pants cannot be cargo jeans, jogger style, or tights. Please see attached document for how to access Valor Christian Leadership Academy's school uniform website. Any student wearing other uniform brands/items or are not dressed according to dress code breakdown below will not be permitted on school campus or school-related event.

The daily dress code breakdown is included below. Order according to your child's biological gender and size.

In addition to the breakdown below, remember the following:

- 1. Only the black uniform cardigan and 2021 black winter jacket are permitted to be worn at school.
- 2. Ladies are required to wear dark solid-colored tights/shorts under skirts. Tights must be shorter than the length of the skirt.
  - 3. Uniforms must be wrinkle-free, stain-free, and stench-free.
  - 4. As the winter season approaches, the school will post a winter dress code policy.

### **Male Students**

#### Hair

- Must be well kept, regularly cut, and combed/brushed daily.
- Length of hair cannot hang in the face or hang pass eyebrow area
- Long hair must keep it out of their face and pulled backed into a ponytail. No high buns.
- Males are not permitted to wear any forms of hair extensions.
- Hair dyes must be natural hair color. No highlights or unnatural dyes

## Piercings

- Only ear piercings are permitted; one earring in each ear
- Studs only, no hoops, loops or stretch piercings
- Male students are not permitted to wear facial or other bodily piercings

Tattoos: Bodily tattoos and bodily markings (i.e. fake tattoos, marker drawings) must be always covered while on campus or at school-related events

Polished nails: Male students are not permitted to wear colored nail polish on campus or school-related events

- Must be neatly groomed, combed/brushed daily.
- Hair cannot hang in the face; length cannot hang pass eyebrow area.
- Long hair must keep it out of face.
- Hair dyes must be natural hair color. No unnatural highlights.
- Weave Extensions can only be worn by female studentss
  - Extensions cannot proceed past the middle of the back or the length of natural hair, whichever is longest.
  - Has to be a natural hair color or highlights that complements the female's skin tone. Brown, Blonde, Black, and Burgundy are permitted
  - o No hair jewelry, beads, yarns, fairy pieces, or bandanas
- Headbands and complementary hair scarves permitted

#### Piercings

- Ear piercings are permitted; no more than 2 earrings in each ear.
- Studs, small-medium hoops only; no large hoop or long dangle earrings
- No stretch piercings
- Girls can only have nostril nose piercings; studs only, no hoops.
- No other facial or bodily piercings are permitted

#### Nails

- Elementary female students are not permitted to wear nail extensions of any type
- Elementary female students may wear polish
- Middle & High School female students may wear nail extensions up to 1 ¼" measurement from the cuticle to tip and will not impede student from completing work effectively.
  - No hanging jewelry from nail designs
